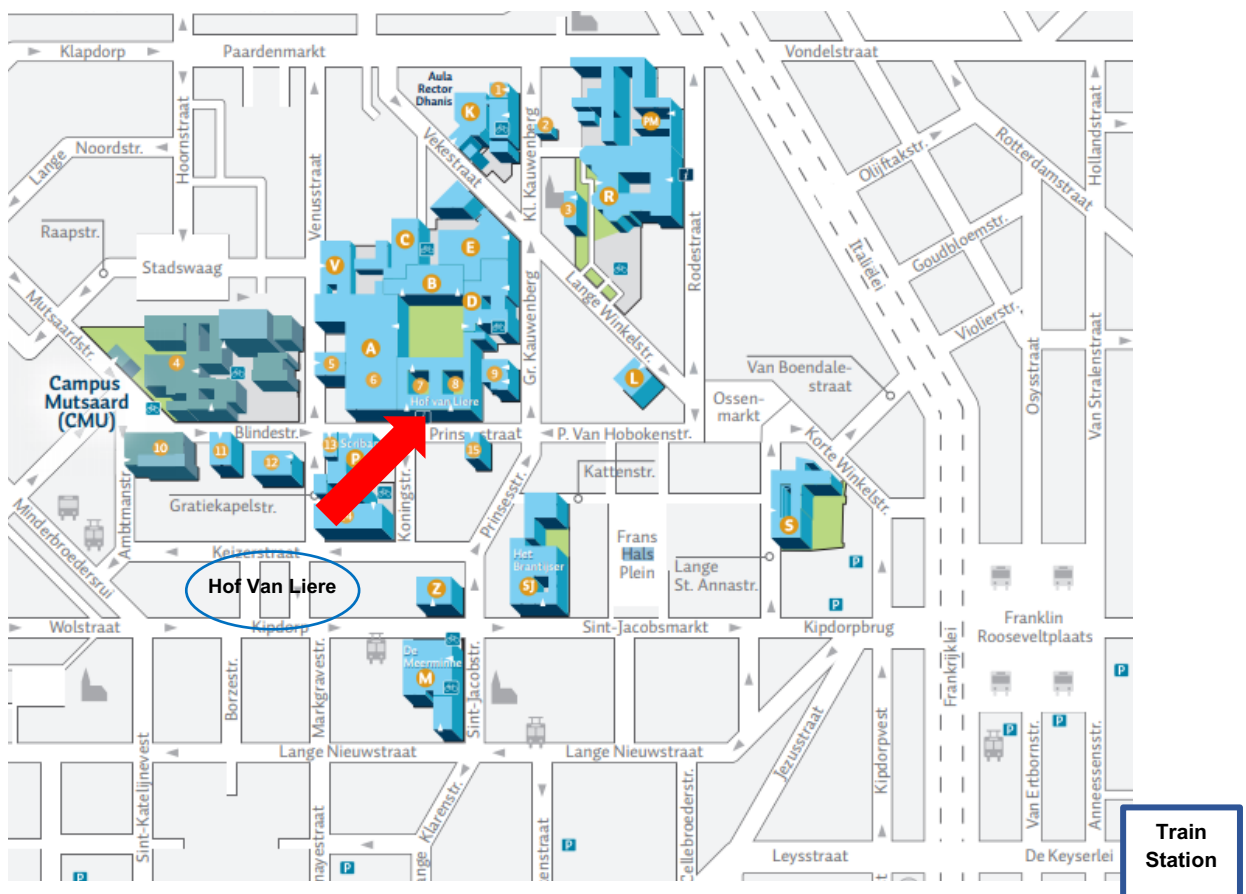
VENUE

The workshop will be held in **Hof Van Liere** in the City Campus of the University of Antwerp.
Address: City Campus – Prinsstraat 13, 2000 Antwerp, Belgium.



The beautiful 16th century **Hof van Liere** is part of the Antwerp cultural-historical patrimony. The adjacent historic buildings that were built by the Jesuits in the 17th century are a haven of peace in the noisy city center. The building complex, named Het Prinsenhof, was equipped as a boarding school in 1575 and later as a military academy and military hospital. In 1988 Het Prinsenhof was purchased by the university and the wings around the courtyard were restored and renovated.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Getting to the event venue

From Brussels-Zaventem Airport

Brussels Airport is the most frequently used gateway to Antwerp.

Take the **train** to conveniently travel from Brussels Airport to Antwerp Central Station. Brussels Airport-Zaventem station is located on level -1 of the terminal. The trip lasts ~38 minutes and the fare is 11.60 EUR. More information on the Belgian Railways website here: <https://www.belgianrail.be/en/>

There is also a **Antwerp-Brussels Airport express**. The stop "Kon. Astridplein" (near the central station) is always served. The trip lasts ~45 minutes and the fare is 10 EUR. More information here: <http://www.airportexpress.be/page?&ori=2&ssn=&lng=2&pge=4>

My Super Shuttle offers door-to-door service from Brussels Airport to the centre of Antwerp. More information here: <https://mysupershuttle.be>

From Brussels South Charleroi Airport

When flying with Ryanair, you can arrive at Brussels South Charleroi Airport. From there, you can travel to Antwerp by train or by bus shuttle. If you travel by train, first take a bus to the Charleroi South train station. The trip to Antwerp lasts ~90 minutes and the fare is 8.30 EUR. From Amsterdam Schiphol Airport

Take the train to conveniently travel from Amsterdam Schiphol Airport to Antwerp Central Station. You can use the Thalys fast train. The trip lasts ~60 minutes and the fare is ~50 EUR. More information here: <https://www.thalys.com/be/en/>

Get around by public transportation

The public transportation company De Lijn (www.delijn.be/en/) operates a dense network of buses, trams, and underground tram connections in the city and its surroundings. A 10-ride card (Lijnkaart) costs 16 EUR. They can be bought at self-service machine or at fixed points (e.g. most supermarkets and any place that sells newspapers). You can also buy a single ticket in the bus. It costs 3.00 EUR. For one fare, you can ride up to 60 minutes.

Free Wi-Fi

Free Wi-Fi is provided at the event venue. Each participant will receive a unique password.

The city of Antwerp also offers free wi-fi zones. On the whole of 'Via Sinjoor', the central route from Central Station to the Scheldt, you can use the city's wifi network for free: Koningin Astridplein, De Keyserlei, Meir, Wapper, Theaterplein, Meirbrug, Schoenmarkt, Groenplaats, Jan Blomstraat, Handschoenmarkt, Grote Markt, Suikerrui en Steenplein.
